




First visit or second opinion

From 2018 to 2019, he was President of the European Society for Medical Oncology (ESMO) and continues to serve as a member of its Board of Directors.

He received the 2019 National Research Prize of Catalonia for his contribution to cancer medicine and, in particular, for his pioneering advances in precision oncology medicine (study of the origin of cancers and the development of adapted therapies).

In addition to his dedication to having a close relationship with his patients, he has a prominent scientific profile and holds a place among leading research scientists. He is active in the **research and development of numerous drugs for colorectal cancer**, as well as in translational research and phase 1 pharmacodynamic studies with targeted molecular therapies.

Oncological Nursing

We have a team made up of three departments, which offers comprehensive care and ensures continuity for the management and administration of oncology drugs as well as the holistic patient and family care process. In addition, the oncology nursing team coordinates our different workshops and conducts nursing studies to improve our patients' quality of life and care.

Clinical nursing

Registered nurse (case manager) specializing in the patient's pathology, who acts as a point of contact between the different departments and provides thorough, personalized tracking with a comprehensive approach.

Day hospital

Experts in outpatient administration and oncology treatment monitoring, following procedures based on scientific evidence to minimize possible side effects. A qualified team specializing in hair cryotherapy for the prevention of hair loss.

Clinical trials

A team that ensures quality of care for patients participating in a clinical trial.



Twin program

A pilot study aimed at patients with non-metastatic breast cancer. Patients with the same characteristics as regards their treatment and personal situation are paired, to evaluate the effect of accompaniment on treatment tolerance and symptoms such as anxiety and depression.












Zero bureaucracy

A holistic approach and 360° treatment

We consider a patient's physical and emotional well-being essential. This is why we offer comprehensive treatment with specialists in oncology nutrition, acupuncture, psychology, psychiatry, hair loss prevention, etc.

Psycho-oncology and oncological psychiatry

After a cancer diagnosis, it is normal to feel a mixture of anxiety and grief.

Our team of specialists can provide help, with advice and strategies for the patient, their family and caregivers throughout the whole process, to come to terms with and manage the emotional pressure that the disease can create.

Nutrition Service

The nutritional recommendations we offer in our Nutrition Department are coordinated with the medical team and are based on scientific evidence, the type of cancer, treatment, symptoms and the patient's preferences.

It is important to provide nutritional support to cancer patients undergoing treatment, to assist them in choosing nutritious foods that they find appetizing and help them minimize any treatment-related side effects. Nutritional intervention should be seen as a support measure within the overall oncology strategy.

Acupuncture

The World Health Organization (WHO) recommends acupuncture as an alternative therapy for the relief of both acute and chronic physical pain. Likewise, as no medication is involved, it is also seen as an established option in the treatment of psycho-emotional symptoms.

Hair Loss Prevention Unit

Hair loss is one of the most distressing and annoying side effects of chemotherapy for patients. Scalp cooling using a cap attached to a machine has proven to be an effective way to prevent or reduce hair loss during chemotherapy treatment in many cases.

Cooling the scalp causes the blood vessels in the dermis to contract, leading to a reduction in blood flow to the hair follicles at the time when the chemotherapy drug is at its highest concentration in the blood.


Aesthetic care

Skin problems such as irritation, redness, itching, scaliness, dryness or acne may occur during cancer treatment. Nails may also become brittle and the patient may experience hair loss as a side effect of chemotherapy. Our nursing team can provide advice on how to minimize these effects and will offer easy recommendations for patients to look and feel better.




Continuous Care Unit




